




Bowing parallel to the strings.




Smooth transition between two bow position.




Ordinary bowing.




String clef: play on the string/s specified in the score.




In this case the string clef indicated to play on the 4th and 3th strings with the parallel bow technique.




Legno battuto. Strings must be damped by the left hand.
In this case the pitch is specified.




Random legno battuto's pitch: in this case just follow the shape in order to achieve a low or high pitch.




Increasing/decreasing vibrato. Follow the shape in order to increase or decrease the amount of vibrato.



Squared notehead: play on the wood of the bridge. The result is a white noise.



Cross notehead: hit the tailpiece with the hand.



Play with the nails on the strings indicated by the string clef.
"O.t.b." means over the bridge.
